

Faculty of Theology

The principal objectives of the Faculty of Theology are to carry out research and teaching, and to communicate God's revelation in Jesus Christ as perceived through faith within the Church, in a historical context using the appropriate scientific methodology.

Theological preparation is offered not only to members of religious communities and candidates for the priesthood, but also to Christian laymen and women who wish to deepen their knowledge of the faith at a university level.

ACADEMIC STAFF:

The academic staff includes a total of 31 full-time and part-time professors, 90% of whom have formal graduate training.

In addition to the Theology major, of canonical value, the Faculty offers a major in Pastoral Studies, focused on those who dedicate themselves to pastoral work.

RESEARCH PROGRAMS AND OPPORTUNITIES INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- A Doctoral program and a Master's program.
- The Center for Latin American Theological Documentation.

- A program on the history of the Church in Chile, and popular religious traditions and practices.
- Two journals for publication of research and investigation: *Teología y Vida*, a quarterly magazine; and *Anales de la Facultad de Teología*, for the publication of doctoral theses and monographs.
- An extension program offering elective courses for students of other Faculties of the University, as well as an evening extension program for systematic theological formation of laymen and women.
