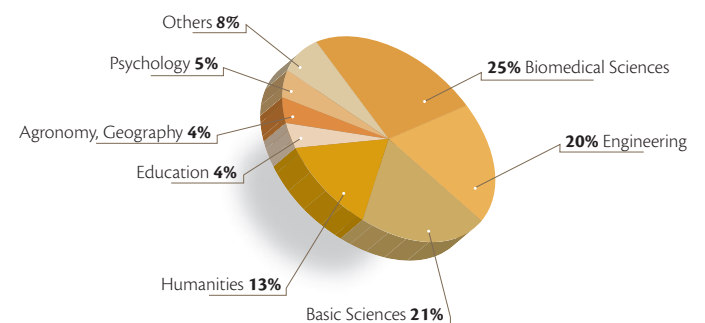

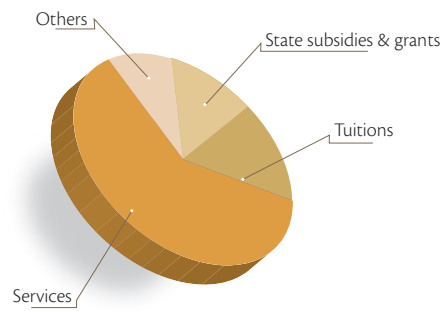

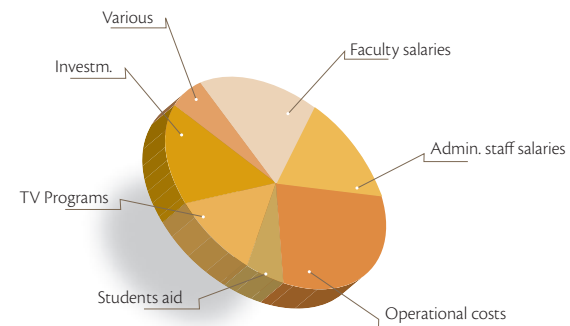
UC Financial Data (2008)

(Including Health Network and TV Network)

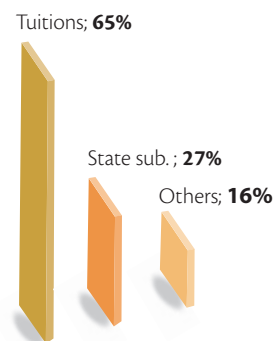


Total expenditures = US\$ 675 millions

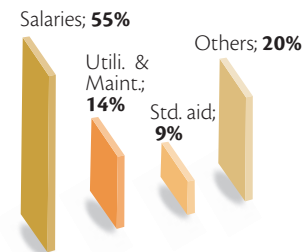
UC 2008 CENTRAL BUDGET
