



## Extension Programs and Activities

The objectives of extension programs are to disseminate the research and teaching of UC's academic departments to the broader community.

Extension activities include educational television programs, the Latin American Crafts Fair, and the UC Performing Arts Center, with two auditoriums and seating capacity for 500 and 300 spectators respectively. Various sculpture exhibitions are also presented by the School of Arts throughout the year.

The UC Theater produces a wide variety of classical, contemporary, and children's plays. The Institute of Music schedules concerts in Santiago and educational concert tours in the provinces and abroad. These are performed by the Chamber Orchestra, the Art Trio, and the Renaissance Quartet. Every year a musical composition contest is also organized to stimulate creativity in music.

The University is constantly displaying films based primarily on theme, movement, director or country cycles. As such, the UC film program, in conjunction with embassies and international cultural centers, has the chance to present movies to the public that normally do not reach the Chilean commercial film circuit.

There is a wide variety of art exhibitions throughout the year. In total, the Visual Arts area displays the art of around thirty national and international artists. Themes and styles are diverse, ranging from vanguard to patrimonial art, photography, crafts, design, and other cultural issues.
